



2012 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The Texas and Southwestern Cattle Raisers Foundation is offering scholarships in the amount of \$2,000.00 (\$1,000 per semester) to students interested in pursuing a degree within the field of agriculture.

QUALIFICATIONS

The candidate must be accepted or enrolled at an accredited university in Texas or Oklahoma and plan to pursue a degree program in agriculture or an agriculture-related program (Animal Science, Pre-Vet, Agribusiness, Range Management or Wildlife):

- The applicant must be a citizen of the United States or be born in the United States and be a resident of the State of Texas or Oklahoma. If place of birth of applicant as indicated on application and/or transcript is other than the United States, appropriate proof of citizenship must be furnished with application.
- The applicant must be a member or sponsored by a member of the Texas and Southwestern Cattle Raisers Association.
- The applicant must have a cumulative 2.75 GPA. Transcripts from all colleges attended must be submitted. If currently a high school senior, please include high school transcript.
- The applicant must submit two personal recommendations from those other than relatives. Recommendation forms are attached.
- The applicant must demonstrate financial need.
- The applicant must have a background that includes beef cattle production.

Scholarships are awarded without regard to race, gender, religion or ethnicity.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

Each scholarship will be paid by check payable to the university that the student will be attending during the upcoming fall semester. The check will be issued by the Texas and Southwestern Cattle Raisers Foundation and mailed to the university.

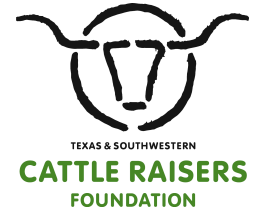

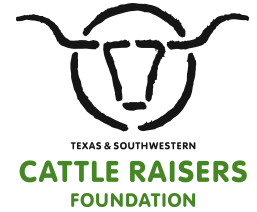
